GOING GREEN WITH GARBAGE

Yes, Culver has garbage! But something new is happening here: WE ARE GOING GREEN. Last summer the Culver town council plunged into its refuse collection problem. Their recycling center, after years of ranking as one of the best in Indiana, had to be dismantled because residents were depositing garbage, not their recycling, into the bins. Heavy garbage trucks were rolling through town three days a week as residents hired any collection company they wished. Recycling was another \$5 per month for pickup, so few signed up. Now the town council has contracted with one company, which will provide receptacles for garbage and recycling for all residents.
