Step 2:

Encourage all employees to visit GetPrepared.in.gov to find resources on how to prepare their home and workplace for an earthquake.

Step 3:

Determine the level of drill your business needs to prepare for an earthquake by reviewing the drill manuals at <http://www.in.gov/dhs/3730.htm>

- **Level 1—Simple:** Drop, Cover and Hold On
- **Level 2—Basic:** Life Safety Drill
- **Level 3—Intermediate:** Decision-Making Drill
- **Level 4—Advanced:** Business Operations Simulation Drill
