

SECOND CENTURY GENERAL MEETING

Minutes – May 25th, 2010 Noon
Culver Public Library

The meeting was called to order by Chairman, Dick Brantingham.

Second Century General Meeting minutes of November 10, 2009 were approved as presented.

- I. Rick Tompos, Treasurer, presented the Treasurer's Report, showing a balance of \$3,460.00, which was approved.
- II. The Culver Kiwanis raffle was explained and tickets were made available to Second Century Members.
- III. Chairman Dick Brantingham gave an overview of the 2010 Projects and Project Champions presented their updates:

Patty Stallings, Affordable Housing:

reported on the Garden Court development, which will be developed on the south end of town with a grant supporting affordable senior citizen housing. Progress has been made with the land's owner's request and was granted by the Culver Town Council that the Town supply utilities to the property. Both parties agreed to work toward completing the housing project.

Jack Cunningham, Recreational Path:

reported that his committee is working with School Superintendent Schult, " Safe Route To School " and researching the possibility of Bike Route signage.

- IV. Guest Speaker, Michael Doss, Culver Town Manager, provided the Long Range Plans for the Town and updated the status of Town Projects. He explained the town has received a grant of \$500,000.00 for downtown revitalization, which would include a 20% match in funds from the town. He said the Town must study the grant and develop an acceptable plan. A question and answer period followed.
